**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MOFFAT, COLORADO, REPEALING
ORDINANCE NO. 2016-01 (AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR
THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF MOFFAT, COLORADO) AND FURTHER ESTABLISHES
COMPENSATION FOR THE MAYOR AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
TOWN OF MOFFAT, COLORADO**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2016-01 referenced C.R.S. 31-4-304, in order to establish compensation for its Town Officers; and

WHEREAS, the Town Clerk has been informed of the lack of applicability of C.R.S. 31-4-304 to said Ordinance and has informed the Board of Trustees of such issue; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. 31-4-301(4) states "The mayor and members of the Board of Trustees shall receive such compensation as fixed by Ordinance"; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that since the monthly time commitment and complexity of Town matters have increased, adequate compensation must be established to cover the costs and expenses of the Mayor and the Board of Trustees.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat, Colorado, that the above referenced Ordinance be repealed in its entirety. Further, be it ordained that compensation for the Mayor and the Board of Trustees be established as follows:

That the compensation for the Mayor and the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat, a statutory town, shall be set at **\$420.00** per month for the duration of the term of office and regardless of the number of meetings they are required to attend.

AND

If the Mayor or a Trustee misses the regular monthly meetings, as set forth in State Statute, due to unexcused absences as determined by the Board of Trustees, the compensation will not be paid to the Mayor or said Trustee for that month.


AND

Compensation of the Mayor and the Board of Trustees shall commence at the beginning of their term of office with the Town of Moffat.
