

ORDINANCE NO. 2-06

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A FOUR YEAR TERM FOR THE
MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF MOFFAT, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Town of Moffat, Colorado is a statutory town of the State of Colorado governed by a Board of Trustees and a Mayor, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor is currently elected for two (2) year terms pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-4-301(2), and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has the authority to provide for a four year term of office for the Mayor pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-4-301(5) as long as such ordinance is enacted at least one hundred eighty (180) days before the next regular election, and as long as such ordinance does not extend or reduce the terms for which any person was elected, and


WHEREAS, the next regular election is scheduled for the first Tuesday of April 2008;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat, Colorado that:



1. Beginning with the April 2008 the Mayor is to be elected to a four-year term of office.
