TOWN OF MOFFAT, COLORADO ORDINANCE NO. 2-2008

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING THE MAYOR TO VOTE ON ALL MATTERS BEFORE THE BOARD OF THE TRUSTEES

WHEREAS, by custom, pattern and practice, the Mayor of the Town of Moffat has not voted in matters before the board, except in the case of a tie vote; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 31-4-202 provides that the Mayor shall have the same voting powers as any member of the board, except that a town may by ordinance provide that the mayor shall not be entitled to vote on any matter before the board, except in the case of tie vote; and

WHEREAS, it is unclear whether the Town of Moffat ever passed such an ordinance enacting its pattern and practice of the Mayor not voting except in cases of a tie vote; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees recently failed to have a quorum to vote on a matter, however it would have had a quorum had the Mayor been entitled to vote as regular member of the board; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to avoid this situation in the future;

NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat, Colorado:

1. That the Mayor shall have the same voting powers as any member of the Board of Trustees pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-4-202.
