ORDINANCE NO. 2-2009**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A COSTS SCHEDULE FOR THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF
THE TOWN OF MOFFAT**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has duly enacted ordinances to provide for the health, welfare, and safety of its citizens and established a municipal court by Ordinance 5-2008,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that is appropriate to impose costs upon defendants in municipal Court that are convicted or enter a plea.


NOW THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat, Colorado:

1. The following costs may be assessed by the Municipal Judge against any defendant in municipal court:
 - a. Court costs upon conviction after trial, or entry of guilty or no contest plea: \$25.00
 - b. Deferred sentence or stay of execution of fine or judgment: \$25.00
2. In the future, the Board of Trustees may amend the costs schedule set out in this ordinance by resolution.
3. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
