ORDINANCE NO. 2007-1

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE MEMBERSHIP AND TERMS OF OFFICE FOR THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF MOFFAT

WHEREAS, the Town of Moffat, Colorado is a statutory town of the State of Colorado governed by a Board of Trustees, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-23-203, the State of Colorado allows municipalities to determine the membership and terms of office for its Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Moffat has had difficulty recruiting and retaining members of the Planning Commission when the said commission is composed of the statutorily established five members; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is in the best interest of the governance of the Town of Moffat to reduce the number of members on the Planning Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat, Colorado that:

- The Planning Commission, upon adoption of this ordinance, shall consist of three members.
- 2. The members shall be one individual from the Board of Trustees and two individuals residing in the Town of Moffat. All members shall be appointed by the Mayor.
- 3. The terms of office for the members of the Planning Commission shall run concurrently with the term of the Mayor's office.
- 4. The Planning Commission shall otherwise be governed by state law.
