TOWN OF MOFFAT, COLORADO ORDINANCE NO. 5-2008

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL COURT FOR THE TOWN OF MOFFAT, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has duly enacted ordinances to provide for the health, welfare, and safety of its citizens, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 13-10-104, a municipality must create a municipal court to enforce its ordinances, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 13-1-111, a municipality may establish a court of record,

NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat, Colorado:

1. That a municipal court is hereby established.

2. The court shall be a qualified municipal court of record.

3. The Court shall keep a verbatim record of the proceeding with a tape recorder in accordance with C.R.S. § 13-10-102.

4. The municipal judge shall be an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Colorado in accordance with C.R.S. § 13-10-102.

5. The court shall hear and try all alleged violations of the Town of Moffat's ordinances.

6. The municipal court shall have all other powers set forth by the laws of the State of Colorado.
