AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING A MUNICIPAL JUDGE, AND SETTING A SALARY, FOR THE TOWN OF MOFFAT, COLORADO,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has duly enacted ordinances to provide for the health, welfare, and safety of its citizens, and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 13-10-105 provides that a municipal court shall be presided over by a judge and gives the Board of Trustees the authority to appoint a municipal judge, and

WHEREAS, Amanda Pearson has indicated that she is willing to serve as the municipal judge for the Town of Moffat.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained that the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat, Colorado:

- 1. Amanda Pearson is hereby appointed as the Municipal Judge for the Town of Moffat.
- 2. Her term shall be from August 5, 2008 until May 3, 2010, in accordance with C.R.S. § 13-10-105
- 3. Ms. Pearson shall not be removed from office except for cause, as designated in C.R.S. § 13-10-105.
- 4. Ms. Pearson's salary shall be \$100 per hour with a \$100 minimum.
