

**RESOLUTION 2008-1  
TOWN OF MOFFAT, COLORADO**

**A RESOLUTION CANCELLING THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND  
DECLARING THE CANDIDATES ELECTED**

**WHEREAS**, it appears to the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat, Colorado, that there are no more candidates for the Board of Trustees of said Town than there are vacant seats to be filled; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to law, an election for these vacant seats will be unnecessary, if no write-in candidates file an affidavit of intent prior to nineteen days before the day of the election; and

**WHEREAS**, according to Town of Moffat Ordinance 2008-1 the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat authorizes the Town Clerk to cancel the April 1, 2008 election if there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at such election, including candidates filing affidavits of intent.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat Colorado:

- A. That, provided no affidavit of intent is timely filed by an eligible write-in candidate, those candidates that filed nomination petitions are hereby declared elected to the Board of Trustees for the following terms and positions at the April regular Town Trustee meeting:

One (4) year term for Mayor: Earl LeRoy

Three (4) year terms for Trustee: John Hussey  
Margie Lewandowski  
Eileen Wilfong

- B. That the election scheduled for the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2008, shall be canceled, as of March 14, 2008, eighteen days prior to the scheduled April 1, 2008, election, if no affidavit of intent has been filed by an eligible write-in candidate.
- C. That TABOR sales tax election scheduled for April 1, 2008, is cancelled and shall be held at the November 2008 general election.
