

**RESOLUTION 2020-7
TOWN OF MOFFAT, COLORADO**

**A RESOLUTION CANCELLING THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND DECLARING
THE CANDIDATES ELECTED**

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat, Colorado, that there are no more candidates for the Board of Trustees of said Town than there are vacant seats to be filled; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, an election for these vacant seats will be unnecessary, if no write-in candidates file an affidavit of intent prior to sixty seven days before the day of the election.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat Colorado:

- A. That, provided no affidavit of intent is timely filed by an eligible write-in candidate, those candidates that filed nomination petitions are hereby declared elected to the Board of Trustees for the following terms and positions at the April regular Town Trustee meeting:

One (4) year term for Mayor
Three (4) year terms for Trustee

Three (2) year terms for Trustee

- B. That the election scheduled for the 7th day of April, 2020, shall be canceled, as of February 4, 2020, sixty three days prior to the scheduled April 7, 2020, election, if no affidavit of intent has been filed by an eligible write-in candidate.

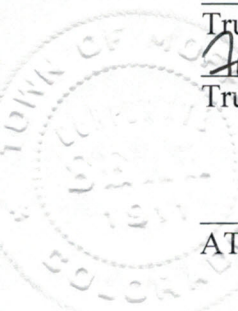


