

**TOWN OF MOFFAT, COLORADO
RESOLUTION NO. 5-2010**

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2011, TO HELP DEFRAID THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE TOWN OF MOFFAT, COLORADO, FOR THE 2011 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 7, 2010, and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes from real property tax revenue is \$3,888, and;

WHEREAS, the 2011 valuation for assessment for the Town of Moffat as certified by the Saguache County Assessor is \$ 394,656.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MOFFAT, COLORADO:

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Town of Moffat during the 2011 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 9.852 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable real property within the district for the year 2011. If Saguache County changes the assessment between the date of this resolution and December 15, 2010, the Board of Trustees hereby delegates authority to the Town Clerk/Treasurer to adjust said mill levy accordingly and to certify a mill levy to the County.

SECTION 2. That the treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Saguache County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Town of Moffat as hereinabove determined and set.


