

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-04

AN *EMERGENCY* ORDINANCE REPEALING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PLANNING COMMISSION FOR THE TOWN OF MOFFAT, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat, a statutory town of the State of Colorado, previously established a "Planning Commission" via Ordinance and pursuant to C.R.S. §31-23-203, *et seq.*;

WHEREAS, the Town of Moffat has had severe difficulty recruiting and retaining citizens to serve on public boards;


WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is desirous of *IMMEDIATELY* implementing *interim* land use regulations for the Town of Moffat, an authority which has been previously ceded to a "Planning Commission" which, for all intents and purposes, does not exist in the Town due to a lack of citizen participation in municipal governance;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is in the best interest of the governance of the Town of Moffat to rescind the authority previously delegated to a "Planning Commission," and for the Board of Trustees to re-assume such power and authority as provided by statute (*inter alia*, C.R.S. §31-23-227(1) to implement land use regulations for the Town of Moffat.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat, Colorado that by the passage of this Ordinance, the Board of Trustees re-assumes the power and authority to implement land use regulations previously delegated to a Planning Commission for the Town of Moffat.
